### Key Benefits

- ET provides faster, more complete control of tough broadleaf weeds such as chickweed, malva, and stinging nettle.
- ET has a different mode of action than phenoxy and ALS inhibiting herbicides which makes ET an excellent choice for managing herbicide resistance in weeds.
- ET can be tank mixed with selective grass herbicides without the risk of antagonism.
- ET can also be tank mixed and applied with liquid fertilizer.

### Use Information

- Apply ET at 1.0 fl oz/A with a silicone or nonionic surfactant.
- Use 5 to 10 gallons spray solution per acre by air; 10 to 20 gallons spray solution per acre by ground.
- Best results are achieved with flat fan nozzles that are calibrated to deliver medium to fine droplet sizes.
- Apply ET to weeds that are less than 4 inches in height or rosettes of 3 inches or less in diameter for the best control.
- ET must be tankmixed with another foliar active broadleaf herbicide like Express<sup>®</sup>, Shark<sup>®</sup>, Simplicity<sup>®</sup>, or MCPA for complete control of certain broadleaf species.
- ET may cause speckling or small discolored necrotic spotting depending upon environmental conditions or if the crop is under stress. These effects are transient and WILL NOT affect crop yield.

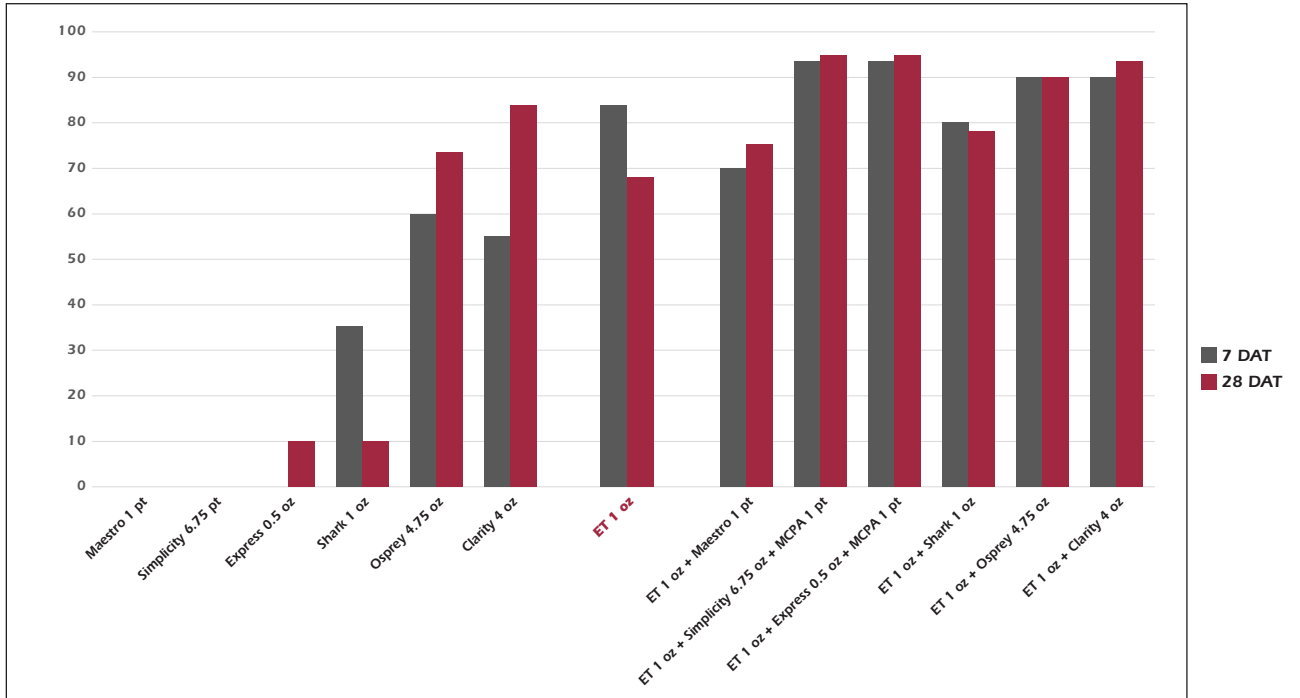

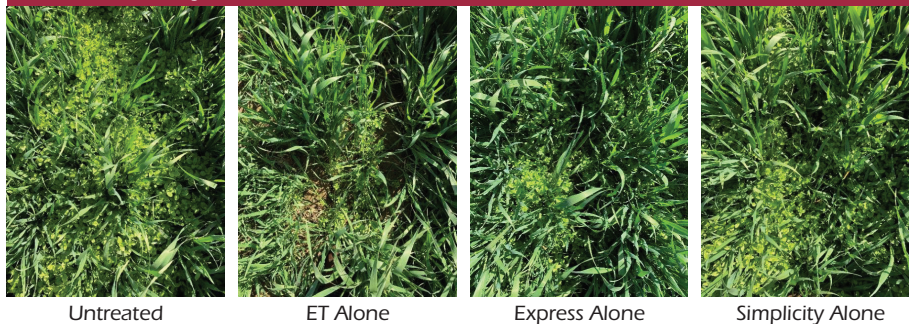

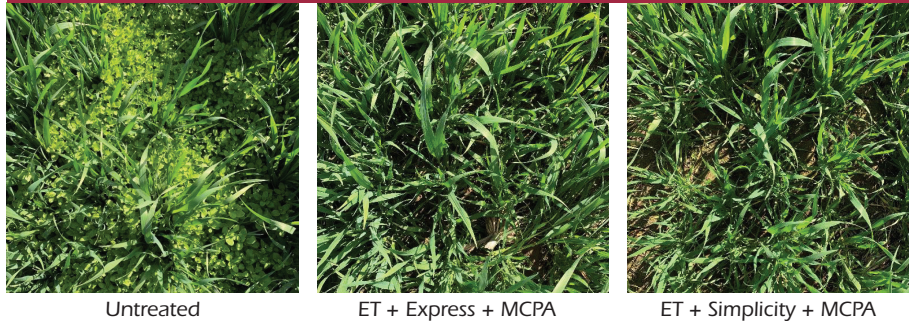
## Herbicide Efficacy on Chickweed in Wheat Traver, CA 2021
